

Young Gamechangers Fund: <u>Co-op Groups/Organisations</u>

Application Questions and Guidance

Thank you for your interest in applying to the Young Gamechangers Fund! These guidelines set out the questions we ask in our application and give some advice about what we are looking for in your answers. We are excited about learning about your work and organisation.

- This application is for groups/organisations within Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland and The Isle of Man that want to apply for either project or unrestricted flexible funding.
- This application is for groups/organisations in England that want to apply for unrestricted flexible funding.
- The panel will develop an assessment process that will ensure representation of projects across all countries of the UK, in line with the priority focus outlined. [link to FAOs about prioritisation]
- Applications must be submitted in English, but please do not worry too much about spelling or grammar.
- We have set word limits on all of the questions to help you as the applicant consolidate your points, – the steering group will also accept short bullet points for answers, this is completely fine as long as you answer the question.

In this section of the application, we want to gather some basic information about your organisation or group. This includes your name, key contacts, location and registration status. Ouestions marked with an asterisk* are required questions.

The Young Gamechangers Fund is dedicated to funding groups and organisations that can clearly demonstrate that their project, activism or campaign has been developed and created by young people and will be led by them. In this section tell us why it's essential that you deliver the work, what would be the potential impact, what social challenge would your work help solve or if your work didn't happen what would be the consequences. **"This work is needed within my community because..."**

How will this funding continue your social action work? (200 words or less) *

Use this space to tell us how this funding will aid you to continue your social action work. If it is unrestricted/flexible funding, let us know what this will contribute towards, and if it is more for delivering a project, how will the project benefit from this funding. "This funding will continue my social action by..."

If you are successful in your application you will need to commit to meet with your Programme Officer at key points through the year to share updates on your project delivery and to make sure that you are meeting the requirements of the grant.

However, part of being a Gamechanger is that we offer a support plan, to help you throughout your time with us as a grantee. In addition to the required check-ins with your Programme Officer above, you can also request up to 5 tailored sessions to meet your individual needs, and also access a mentor, training, and opportunities to connect with other young activists and organisations (which you can find in the FAOs).

If your application is successful your Programme Officer will introduce you to the support offer and share all of the opportunities available.
